Trustee Kiko called the meeting to order and led the staff and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustee Kiko excused Fire Chief Rich Peterson from tonight's meeting.

Trustee Kiko reminded the residents who signed up to speak of the 5-minute time limit for public speaks.

Joanne Moody of 7018 Pilot Knob stepped to the podium regarding:

• Phone call scam

Discussion – Ms. Moody informed the Board and residents about a phone call scam she received regarding her social security being cancelled.

Jim Morris of 4514 Eastland stepped to the podium regarding:

• Ditching on Bentler Ave.

Discussion – Mr. Morris asked Interim Road Superintendent Jamie May about the progress of the ditching on Bentler Ave. Mr. May stated they relieved the water in the ditch. Mr. Morris asked if they removed the tree from the ditch on the other side of the road. Mr. May said he will look at that tomorrow.
